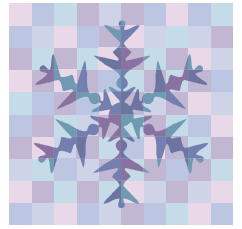

As our minds swirl around with all the decisions we must make about Honduras one thing that stuck out was we can't forget what God has called us to do, and that is help the Honduran people however we can.

Winter plans for Honduras

After a recent board meeting with BHM directors we have decided that we will continue on as planned with Christmas Hampers . We know this is one of our biggest outreaches we can do. We are blessed to have Mariano and his church and Ivan and his church come along side and take on the job of putting together these food hampers and delivering them. Ester is already busy sewing up the 80 bags we pray will be delivered in our absence. Instead of cancelling Honduras for this winter season we have decided that I will lead a group of 11 down at the end of January to make sure all things are in place for the school and school season ahead. We also will be reroofing the mission house and plans are also under way to start up another small feeding centre in a neighbouring village. All houses and playgrounds that were on the schedule for this year will be put off until a later date when we can commit more time. All monies raised for these projects have been set aside and will be waiting for the right time.

The feeding centre in El Pino continues to run after 3 years and with that experience we are ready to expand to another location.

We have a site picked out and when we are there we will work on setting up the new one. The Lord Willing. The school continues to run and Graduation will take place in November. We are excited to see that the school has once again put in another productive year. Each year we see increased commitment to the school and advancing the children. We are very thankful for the dedicated staff. Reminder to all as well receipts will be sent out early 2018 for the 2017 monies received but they must be received before Dec. 29th .

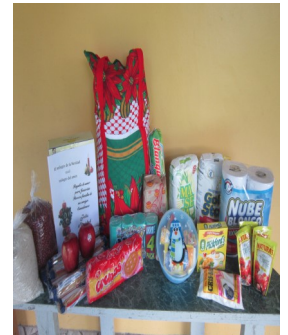
